

 - User Account (NLB myLibrary ID)


NLB myLibraryID

- ⦿ **As long as you are a library member, you can sign up for myLibraryID.**
- ⦿ You may sign up:
 - ⦿ **Online** at <https://account.nlb.gov.sg/> with your BC number
 - ⦿ From **NLB Mobile App** with your BC number
- ⦿ You will *need to key in your email address and your mobile number.
- ⦿ You will receive a one-time password (OTP) on your mobile phone.
- ⦿ Your **User ID** has to have 6-20 alphanumeric characters. You cannot use special characters nor your BC number. Your User ID cannot be changed once you have set it.
- ⦿ Your **password** has to have 8-24 characters and must include 1 letter and 1 number.

* If you do not have an email address and/or mobile number, please get assistance from your parent/guardian.


NLB Overdrive account

- The app is available for download on the Apple App Store and Google Play




NLB Overdrive account

- ◉ Click on your downloaded eBook to start reading.


